From Barbara . . .

The last two weeks we've heard gospel stories where Jesus was being asked by the Jewish leaders to explain his teaching in light of current practices. Do we pay taxes or not? Which is the greatest commandment? This week, Jesus challenges them and their followers to "walk the walk." He essentially tells the leaders to practice what they preach and tells the followers to not follow the example of the leaders since what they do is for show. A few weeks ago I asked the question would someone know that you were Christian by your behavior. I think most of us do behave in an ethical and caring way to the people we come in contact with. Improvement, however, is always possible. Take time this week to be a certain but humble Christian.

This week we celebrate two holy days. The Feast of All Saints is a holy day of obligation (I like to say opportunity) where we celebrate the doctrine of the communion of saints. As Catholics we have so many people who have gone before us whom we can use as examples of faith. Some of these people the Church has recognized and canonized as saints. But some are people who have crossed our paths and made a difference in our lives in some way. Masses for this feast will be at 8:00 am at Our Lady of Mount Carmel and 7:00 pm at St. Anthony. The Commemoration of all the Faithful Departed (All Souls) is a celebration of all those who have gone before us to their heavenly reward. We will have a Mass which will especially honor all those who have died this year and who had their funeral or burial at one of our parishes. We will also be including Fr. Shaum this year. So please join us for these celebrations of our ancestors in faith. Details about the All Souls Day Mass are elsewhere in the bulletin. May they rest in peace.

Another comment on our survey was about having a parish priest for our spiritual needs. By canon law, every parish that has a Pastoral Life Director also has an assigned priest for sacramental and spiritual needs. When I first came here Fr. Jack Lombardi filled that role for 2 years. When he was reassigned, Fr. Mike Kuhn unofficially helped us then Fr. John Lesnick was and Fr. Larry Donohoo is now our assigned priest. I know it has been 3 quick turnovers but unfortunately that's been the nature of the priesthood these days. I have a friend who has been ordained 7 years and has changed parishes every 2 years, two places as an associate and two as pastor. Even parishes with priest pastors have rapid rotations of priests. Please continue to pray for priestly vocations and for all who are called to serve the church.

May God continue to bless us all.
